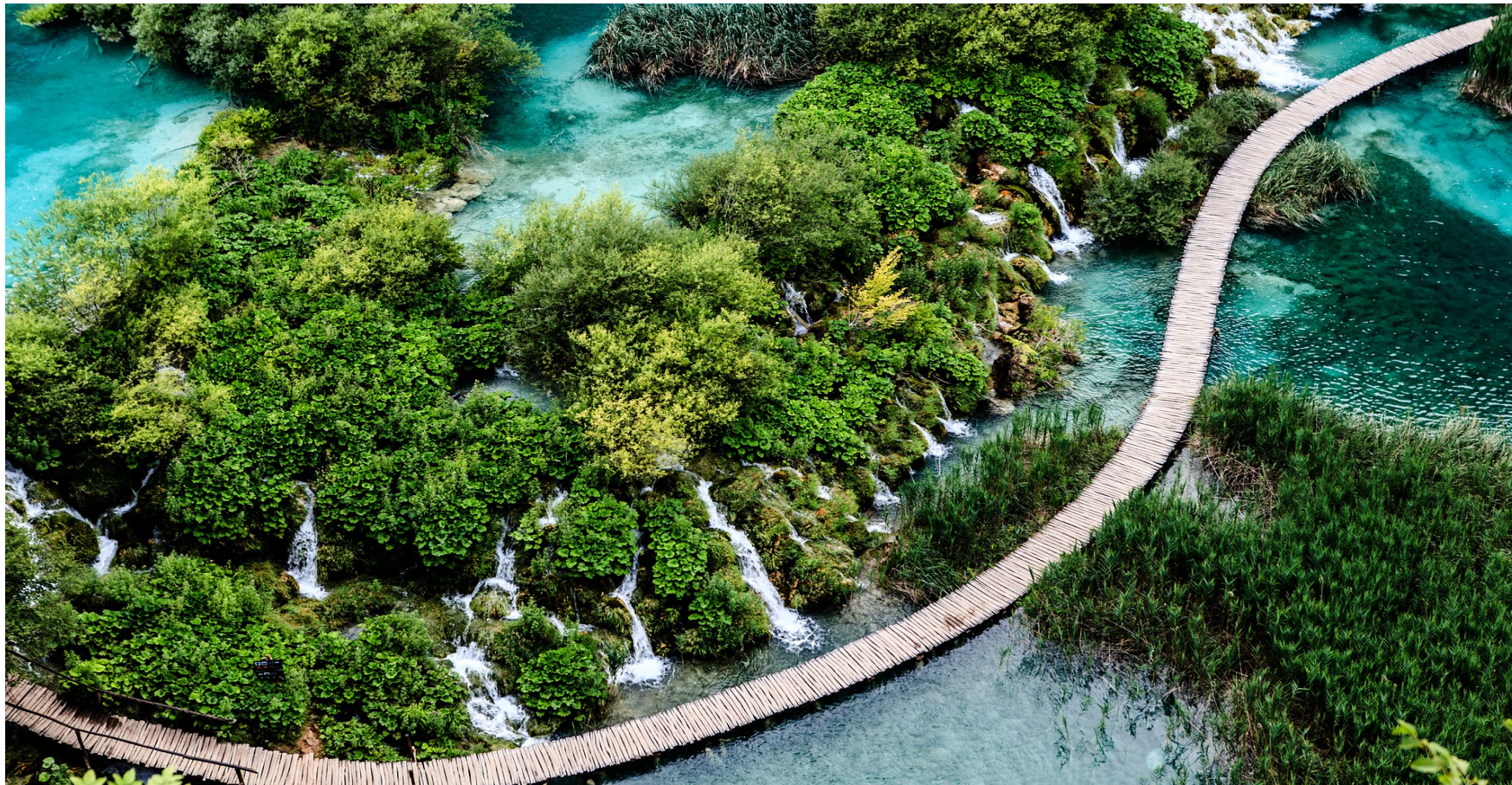

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TOURS INFORMATION & DESCRIPTIONS

1. PLITVICE Lakes, NP

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ITINERARY: Situated in the Region of Lika, in the part of Croatia that is due to its exceptional natural beauties used to be called Devil's Garden, Plitvice Lakes are truly a small piece of Heaven on Earth. Many times proclaimed as one of the most beautiful places in the world, 16 lakes and their waterfalls are among most visited and popular sights of Croatia. It is not just about the relaxing sound of water and stunning landscapes, Plitvice also provide you a cultural elevation giving you the chance to learn about life and traditions of the people living in the area. National Park is inhabited by many protected plant and animal species so all the visitors are kindly asked to respect the rules concerning the ecology, flora and fauna. Plitvice Lakes are also Croatian oldest National Park and only Croatian natural sight in the UNESCO's World Heritage Register. Lakes are divided into the Upper and Lower Lakes. Their characteristic is water saturation with dissolved calcium carbonate that in combination with the force of water dispersion creates travertine.

Main attractions of Plitvice:

Upper Lakes – this group includes 12 of 16 Plitvice lakes separated of each other by the travertine barriers.

Kozjak Lake – is the largest and the deepest lake in Plitvice Lakes National Park. It belongs to the group of Upper Lakes. Nature played merging two smaller lakes into one and created Kozjak, the only navigable lake of Plitvice. On the lake stands a travertine Stephanie's island that was named by the Austrian princess who visited the Park in distant 1888.

Lower Lakes – idyllic scenes of small waterfalls, turquoise water and surrounding greenery characterize this group of lakes. Nearby is situated the underground cave of Šupljara.

Great Waterfall – located within the group of Lower Lakes, with the height of 78 meters is the highest waterfall in Croatia.

2. KRKA Waterfalls NP & ŠIBENIK

ITINERARY: Krka National Park is located in Šibenik County. It covers the area of Krka River and lower course of Čikola River including seven waterfalls, the spring of Krka, animal and plant habitats, archeological sites, sacral architecture, ethnographical and industrial heritage. The Park is a place of exceptional values, unique for its extraordinary travertine formations. Travertine is a limestone that is formed in water with high concentrations of dissolved calcium bicarbonate. Krka National Park is an inevitable Croatian landmark, its natural beauties, interesting history and welcoming local residents will most certainly leave you breathless.



The main attractions of Krka National Park:

Skradinski buk is the biggest of seven waterfalls on the Krka River. Covering the area of 400 m in length and 100 m in width, with its 17 cascades it's the largest travertine cascade system in Europe. However, it is also the most attractive part of Krka National Park. Swimming is allowed at the foot of the waterfall and many park's visitors enjoy there in refreshing moments during the hot summer days.

Visovac is a small island situated on the homonymous lake between the waterfalls Skradinski buk and Roški slap. It is in the property of Franciscan monks who warmly receive their guests from all

over the world. During the last 500 years the monastery of Our Merciful Mother and the church of Our Lady of Visovac have been visited by numerous pilgrims. It is an oasis of spirituality and place where many people come in order to find tranquility and serenity. Water mills on Krka River are important monuments of economic past of Šibenik Region. During the history wheat was milled there for numerous towns all over Dalmatia.

Burnum – the ruins of ancient Roman military camp stand near the village of Ivoševci. Erected in the 1st century as a strategically important position for controlling passage across the river, it marked the starting point of all military campaigns towards the inland regions.

Jaruga hydroelectric power plant was constructed and started working in 1895, just two days after Tesla's hydroelectric plant on Niagara Falls became operational. At the same time, 11 km of power lines to transmit electricity and a city lighting network were built, so Šibenik had electrical lighting before many European cities. It was the first complete electricity system in Croatia.

Except the National Park on this excursion you are going to visit **Šibenik**, old coronation town of Croatian kings, established in the 11th century. One of its sights, St. James' Cathedral is listed in the Register of UNESCO's World Cultural Heritage. Šibenik is quite small and has a lovely promenade where you can take a walk and enjoy the sea view. Above the city stands St. Michael's fortress dating from the 15th century. It is a typical Dalmatian town with narrow streets and many monuments of historical importance. We are sure its charm will overwhelm you.

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3. HALF Day SAILING • morning or afternoon



ITINERARY: Zadar canal is a sea passage between Zadar and island of Ugljan. It's a place of beautiful sea landscapes and rich undersea world. There are numerous islets spread all over the canal and every one of them tells its own unique story.

Departure from Zadar early in the afternoon. Sailing through the Zadar canal towards the island of Ugljan. Sailing boat docks in Preko, small island village. You can take a walk around small port or have a coffee in one of the beach bars, take a swim or visit the nearby islet of Galevac, the green oases

where is located old monastery from 14th century.

Sailing continues towards the secluded bay where you can completely relax and enjoy the crystal clear Adriatic sea.

On your way back to Zadar, our skipper will show you the basics of sailing.

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4. FULL Day SAILING



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ITINERARY: The bay of Telašćica is located on the south-eastern part of the Dugi otok island. It is the largest and best protected natural harbor on the eastern coast of the Adriatic. There are five islets in the bay of which the most extraordinary is the islet of Taljurić that is actually a small rock slab. The area abounds with richness of flora and fauna. Within the park is situated a donkey reserve. Lake Mir is situated in the south-western part of the Park. The water in the lake is salty due to the underground canals that are connected with the sea. Archeological excavations made in the area indicate that the place was inhabited from the earliest periods.

Departure from Zadar in the morning. Cruising towards the southern part of the Dugi Otok Island where the sea embraces Telašćica. Use the sailing time for relaxing while reading the book, sunbathing or simply enjoy in picturesque Mediterranean landscapes. Upon arrival at the Nature Park you will have some free time for swimming and snorkeling. Take a walk around and don't be afraid of the donkeys. They are tamed but like people, especially if you give them a treat. The tour continues with short sightseeing of the salt lake Mir. Afterwards the boat departs towards Zadar and stops for a short swim in a secluded bay. On your way back to Zadar your skipper will show you the basics of sailing

5. ZADAR Market Tour & COOKING Class

ITINERARY: Experience local cuisine at its best !



Welcome to Zadar, a place where tradition meets the urban vibe. Here, on the medieval city square accompanied by the music of the Sea Organ and tempting smells from the nearby restaurants and bistros starts your cooking adventure.

Zadar, the historic center of the mighty Venetian Republic and the capital of entire Dalmatian Region cherishes many unique recipes and traditions related to food. During the past it was an important harbor on the Adriatic Sea and home of many foreigners, merchants, sailors and traders who enriched the local cuisine by introducing Mediterranean herbs and various spices to simple local meals.

The area of Zadar is very diverse, in front of the city there are numerous islands where people have been living from fishing through centuries. Hinterland abounds with fertile soil that has been cultivated till nowadays. All kinds of fruits and vegetables have been grown there but the most popular are authentic sorts of figs, olives and cherries. In the modest households of the islands and hinterland to have a cattle was considered

a big fortune and people quickly learnt how to make the best of it. Thanks to their knowledge Zadar Region is now home of the awarded world's best cheeses such as Hard Pag Cheese made from sheep's milk.

Cooking Classes are a great way of really getting to know the area of Zadar. We all know that the food brings the best of people and we have a special treat for you here in Zadar.

Our cooking class starts at cafe Lovre on the central square of the city. It is one of the cafes with longest tradition in Zadar which in its interior hides a true gem – ancient early-romanesque church. Imagine yourself starting a day as a local with a cappuccino in a centrally located bar discussing about what you would like to have for lunch or supper. There you will meet your guide who will afterward give you a short tour of the city center. You will explore the market, place that was during the past the center of religious life of Zadar, quite extraordinary, isn't it?!

Every day hard working people from the countryside and nearby islands bring their fresh products early in the dawn on the market. Here, the area of the market is not just a place where people buy and sell goods, it is a common area where everyone mingles and meets the old friends. Along with your guide you will choose the ingredients for the lunch or supper, there are so many choices here in Zadar: fresh fish and other sea food, varieties of fruits and vegetables, hard and soft cheeses, honey from the Velebit Mountain, fresh eggs, Dalmatian smoked ham, grappas, liquors, wine... The menu is up to you, the guide and the chef are always there to give you some tips about the traditional local meals. You will also get the chance to taste the products before the final decision.

After shopping follows your cooking class ! The chef will be at your disposal all the time to give you some hints, show you some special techniques and share with you small secrets of Dalmatian cuisine. Enjoy your time preparing the meal and Bon Appetit !

ITINERARY: The tour starts with the boarding in Gaženica port. The one-way ferry ride lasts for 1,5 hours. During the ferry ride you'll have the opportunity to discover a beauty of magical Zadar archipelago on the sunny deck.

Our guide will welcome you in Brbinj, Dugi Otok, in front of the ferry. After the 15-minutes ride, we'll arrive to the white sandy beach Veli Žal. On the first part of our adventure you'll be able to choose what you want to do.. enjoy the

beach and swimming, researching the surroundings in kayak by yourself or join the guide on the ride around the island Mezanj.

Two hours later, our van will transfer you to another bay from which the real adventure starts! Try cliff jumping, swimming and diving in the astonishing cave which changes colours, depending on sun

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reflection/the angle of sunlight incidence. Experience an unforgettable adventure you'll remember for a long time!

The final part of the tour is spent at the white sandy beach of Sakarun, where you can relax, swim and play the local game of picigin – a real treat for all.
